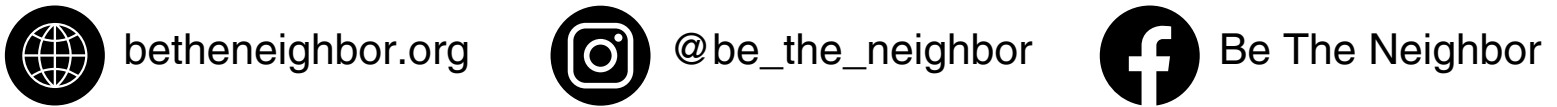




Our Mission

COMPENSATION

Upon completion of the internship, first year interns will receive either a **\$3,000 scholarship or stipend**. Second year interns will receive an **extra \$500**.

Be the neighbor will cover the cost of meals, housing, and travel to and from each service city. We can also provide up to \$150 to get to training in Fort Worth, TX.
