POSITION: **Transitional** Associate Pastor for Youth, Mission, and Community Engagement

The **Transitional** Associate Pastor for Youth, Mission, and Community Engagement is responsible for providing Christian Education and fellowship opportunities for the youth of the church. This pastor also works in the larger community in the area of Mission and Social Justice. This pastor is responsible for integrating youth into the life of the whole church. This position is supervised by the Head of Staff.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- Strengthen and staff a program that engages all ages of the congregation in the work of social justice, including matters of racial justice, houselessness, and poverty
- Support the congregation, session, and staff through changes related to the future of Westminster
- Plan and implement a relationship-based Christian education and fellowship program for the church's youth from grades six to twelfth
- Work with the broader congregation to integrate the youth into the life of the church by making programs more intergenerational
