



## Campus Minister for Furman UKirk

**Purpose:** The Campus Minister for Furman UKirk fosters a Christ-centered community where students can explore faith, ask meaningful questions, and grow in discipleship. Using the guide of the UKirk model of the Presbyterian Church (USA), the Campus Minister will develop programming for students, caring for their spiritual, emotional, and faithful development.

**Core Values:** Furman UKirk is a family of faith encouraged by and committed to:

- Wrestling with Scripture, acknowledging its authority, and trusting the Holy Spirit to speak through it.
- Experiencing God's grace and witnessing Christ's love as we seek to serve others whether at Furman, in Greenville or throughout the world.
- Worshiping and studying the living Triune God, through food, fun, and fellowship.

**Candidate Qualifications:** Preference will be given to candidates who are members of the PC(U.S.A.) and who have experience, and a passion for, working in young adult or college ministry.

**Accountability:** The Campus Minister for Furman UKirk serves under the supervision of the Furman UKirk Advisory Council and the host church. The campus minister must also fulfill all the requirements of the Furman University Office of Spiritual Life in order to serve on campus.

**Responsibilities:**

- **Plan, lead, and evaluate weekly ministry programming** throughout the academic year.
- **Coordinate and promote student participation** in the Montreat College Conference each January.
- **Design and facilitate seasonal retreats** (fall and spring) that support spiritual growth and community building.
- **Provide pastoral care and spiritual support** to students, including maintaining a regular and visible presence on campus.
- **Mentor and support student leadership**, including advising elected UKirk officers.
- **Collaborate with campus ministry partners** by attending Furman Campus Ministers' meetings and following institutional guidelines for campus ministry. Participate in chapel life at Furman, attending regularly and offering leadership as appropriate.
- **Engage in shared leadership and accountability** by participating in and reporting to the Furman UKirk Advisory Council.
- **Cultivate relationships** with congregations, ministers, and advocates across Foothills Presbytery. Participate actively in the life of the Presbytery, including attendance at all Stated Meetings (typically three times a year).
